**Poster Presentation - Format Guidelines**

For those accepted by this webinar for the "Poster Format" presentation, please make a poster in "A1" size (59.4cm wide x 84.1cm high) according to the following specifications. This webinar's poster presentation adopts one paper per board. Please make it according to the unified format.

**I. Basic Information**

(1) The poster title includes the topic and author information as follows:

The poster must have the words "2024 Talent Cultivation in Africa - International Webinar on International Health Field Alliance."

Title XXXXXX

School Department or Unit Name 1, School Department or Unit Name 2

(2) Poster title format suggestions:

1. The paper's title (required): The font size range is 40 to 80, and it should not exceed two lines, center aligned.
2. Author's names: The font size range is 30 to 40, center aligned.
3. Affiliated information: School department or unit name (complete title): The font size range is 30 to 40, center aligned.

**II. Poster Content Format**

(1) Poster content:

Mainly presenting research results, in addition to the extended abstracts, it includes an introduction, literature review, research methods, conclusion, references, etc. The content is up to the author to consider as long as it does not exceed the poster size.

(2) Poster format suggestions :

1. Leave at least 5 cm on the poster paper's top, bottom, and sides.  
Please use bold Times New Roman for the title font.
2. Except for the title and author information, which are one-column and center-aligned, others are designed in a two-column format on one page.
3. Charts must be presented with good resolution; they can be listed in the text or after the references. For those listed in the text, please try to be close to the first mention in the text. Each figure and table should have an explanation of the content. The explanation of the figure should be placed below the figure, and the explanation of the table should be placed above the table.
